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MEMORANDUM

The post of Panchayat Executive Officer (PEO) is the base level and single post of the Odisha Panchayat Executive Officers Service Cadre under Panchayati Raj and Drinking Water Department. The post of PEO is a District Cadre Post. The post carries the Pay of Level-5 as per the Odisha Revised Scale of Pay (ORSP) Rules, 2017. The post belongs to Group-C category.

The vacant posts of Panchayat Executive Officer (PEO) will be filled by way of Direct Recruitment as per the provisions contained in Odisha Panchayat Executive Officers Service (Method of Recruitment and Conditions of Service) Rules, 2021 as amended from time to time through competitive examination conducted by Odisha Sub-Ordinate Staff Selection Commission (OSSSC).

At present, One Thousand Five Hundred One (1501) numbers of vacant posts of PEO in different Districts are required to be filled up by way of Direct Recruitment.

The District-wise and Category-wise Sanctioned Strength, Persons-in-Position, Vacancy Position as well as other necessary details has been prepared in the new prescribed format provided by the ST&SC Development and M&BC Welfare Department and annexed as Annexure-A.

Further, a detailed break-up of the vacancies as per vertical and horizontal reservations has been prepared and annexed as Annexure-B.

Justification for filling up of vacant posts of PEO:

A PEO holds a key post in the Grama Panchayat (GP). He is entrusted with the various works of the GP, such as:

- To open and stay at GP Headquarters,
- To maintain all files, records, registers, Cash Book, etc. of the GP,
- To discharge the duty as the custodian of all records, documents and valuables of the GP,
- To maintain Accounts of GP, keeping the Bank Pass Book updates and reconciling with Cash Book,
- To maintain Flexi Accounts of all Schemes and GP Funds,
- To exercise such other power and duties as may be conferred or assigned to him/her under OGP Act,

- To execute all Development works of the GP,
- To record GP Meeting proceedings and follow up action taken reports,
- To record proceedings of Standing Committee,
- To ensure auction of GP Property for augmentation of OSR and GP resources,
- To maintain and upgrade GP assets,
- To collect license fees and uncollected demand of the GP,
- To prepare Annual Budget of the GP,
- To release timely payment of honorarium of WMs/ SEMs/ GP Staff/ Pump Operators/ Jogana Sahayaks & Others,
- To obtain license for sale of PDS commodities to the NFSA/ OSFSS beneficiaries & maintain the stock & account,
- To boost the income of the GP & increase OSR,
- To maintain all stock & store items of the GP,
- To maintain PWs/ TWs of the GP & ensure supply of safe drinking water to all HHs,
- To work as PIO of the GP under RTI Act,
- To prepare Annual Action Plan, GPDG under CFC/ SFC & Other Schemes,
- To prepare Labour Budget of the GP under MGNREGS,
- To execute MGNREGA works as per approved Labour Budget & to develop Rural Park, Rural Hat, Library & beautify traditional water bodies,
- To conduct surveys like SECC, data updation & sanitization of PWL under Rural Housing,
- To collect documents from beneficiaries under RH & other Schemes,
- To Geo Tag Photos of RH beneficiaries in Awas App/ Ama Ghar App,
- To work as Tagged Officer under Rural Housing to ensure completion of all Houses under PMAY/ BPGY/ NSPGY/ Mining and other Scheme, in time,
- To maintain Wait List at the GP Level under all Pension Schemes like MBPY/ NSAP and distribute pension at the GP Headquarters,
- To operate free kitchen and relief distribution during Natural calamity,
- To identify beneficiaries under NBFS & recommend to the Panchayat Samiti,
- To effect ward division and prepare voter list for 3-tier PRI election,
- To work as Polling/ Sector/ Counting Personnel during election as per orders of DEO-cum-Collector,
- To ensure SHG Bank Linkage & conduct Samanwya Melas with Bank Branches,
- To ensure functioning of MASS (Madhubabu Aain Sahayata Sibira) at GP Headquarters rendering required assistance to the Lawyer concerned,



- To work as facilitator for Skill Development Programmes like DDU-GKY,
- Grievance redressal on every Monday at GP Headquarters.

Also, PEO performs any other works as assigned by Government/ Collector/ BDO from time to time. For smooth management of the above works, the Collectors as well as Elected Representatives are pressing hard to fill up the existing vacancies in the post of PEO.

The job chart of PEOs circulated vide PR & DW Department Letter No.20576 dated 30.10.2018 and No.22458 dated 27.09.20240 have been annexed as Annexure-B.

Further, out of the total sanctioned strength of 372 number of posts of Gram Panchayat Development Officer (GPDO) of the Odisha Panchayati Raj Service Cadre; 50% of the Posts (i.e. 186 number of posts) are filled by way of Promotion from among the eligible PEOs as per the provisions contained in Odisha Panchayati Raj Service (Method of Recruitment and Conditions of Service) Rules, 2023 (Annexure-C).

Financial Implication:

The post of PEO comes under Non-Plan Sector. Necessary Budget provision is required to be made for the salary and other entitlements for the proposed 1501 posts. The detailed financial implication per annum for filling up of 1501 posts of PEO is given below:

Basic Pay:	1501 x Rs.21,700/-	=	Rs.3,25,71,700/-

Method of Recruitment:

Above vacancies in the posts of PEO shall be filled up by way of direct recruitment through competitive examination as per Odisha Panchayat Executive Officers Service (Method of Recruitment and Conditions of Service) Rules, 2021 as amended from time to time. The competitive examination shall be conducted by



the Odisha Sub-Ordinate Staff Selection Commission (OSSSC). After completion of competitive examination process, the OSSSC shall recommend the provisionally selected candidates to the Collectors of Districts concerned. The Collectors of Districts shall issue appointment orders in favour of the candidates selected through the competitive examination following due procedure as per prevailing rules/ guidelines.

Steps taken for fill up of earlier approved vacancies

Previously, recruitment to the post of PEO (earlier designated as Village Level Worker) was conducted by respective Collectors of the Districts as the post belongs to District Cadre.

However, as per the guidelines of the Finance Department Resolution No.22989/F, dated 05.08.2014 and subsequent guidelines issued by the FD in this respect, the total vacancy positions of the post of PEOs in all the Districts are being consolidated by the Administrative Department i.e. PR & DW Department and placed before the Empowered Committee for approval in order to proceed with the direct recruitment.

Accordingly, in 2022, as per the approval of Empowered Committee recruitment examination was conducted by OSSSC vide Advertisement No.492(C)/OSSSC, dated 24.02.2023 for filling up 2297 vacant posts of PEO. Subsequently, Districts After completion of all stages of recruitment procedure by OSSSC appointment orders were issued by Collectors of Districts concerned.

Timeline for completion of the recruitment process

OSSSC is the recruiting agency for the post of PEO. After getting approval of the Empowered Committee to fill up the vacant posts, Collectors are instructed to submit requisitions to OSSSC through Online Mode for filling up of the vacancies by direct recruitment. OSSSC publishes consolidated advertisement based on requisitions received from all Collectors. After completion of all recruitment procedures, Collectors of concerned Districts issue appointment order in favour of the selected candidates as per communication of OSSSC.

In view of the above, this proposal is placed before the Empowered Committee for their kind consideration and views.

Court Cases

Hon'ble High Court, Orissa have passed interim orders in various court cases (W.P.(C) No.22812 of 2021 and other similar cases) filed by a number of Gram Rojagar Sevaks (GRS) working in different Districts challenging the direct recruitment to the post of Panchayat Executive Officer (PEO) as per Odisha Panchayat Executive Officers Service (Method of Recruitment and Conditions of Service) Rules, 2021 and praying for



appointment to the post of PEO as per previous Recruitment Rules which provided for absorption of GRS to the post of PEO against 30% vacancies. The list of such cases is placed at for kind reference.

Following facts may be stated here in connection with aforementioned case:

- Govt. has notified the “Odisha Panchayat Executive Officers Service (Method of Recruitment and Conditions of Service) Rules, 2021” by Notification dated 29.07.2021 (for short “PEO Rules, 2021”) superseding the previous Recruitment Rules. Hence, no appointment can be granted according to superseded Rules, which provided for absorption of GRS in the post of Village Level Workers (VLWs), re-designated as Panchayat Executive Officer (PEO), against 30% vacancies.
- Govt. has brought out a new “PEO Recruitment Rules, 2021” vide Notification dated 29.07.2021 by superseding the previous Recruitment Rules wherein GRS who are less than 45 years of age are eligible to apply and they shall be allowed 1 percent (1%) extra marks of the total marks of the examination for each completed year of continuous service. The opportunity of the Petitioners for appointment to the Post of PEO has not been taken away by the PEO Rules, 2021. Adequate safeguards have been provided in the PEO Rules, 2021 to protect the interest of the existing GRS.
- Government in the meantime has also been pleased to make provision for appointment to the post of Accountant-cum-Data Entry Operator (ADEO) by selection from among the GRS vide this Department Notification No.4727 dated 27.02.2024. Hence, additional opportunity for appointment to a regular post under the Panchayati Raj & Drinking Water Department has been provided to the GRS working in the State.
- Further, PEO holds a key post in the Grama Panchayat (GP). PEOs are entrusted with the various works of the GP, and they perform any other work as assigned by the Government/ Collector/ BDO from time to time. The justification for filling up of vacant posts of PEO has been enumerated above.

Hence, I.A. No. 8632 of 2025 has been filed before the Hon'ble High Court in consultation with the Learned AG, Odisha, Cuttack with a prayer to vacate interim order dated 21.03.2023 passed by the Hon'ble High Court, Orissa in I.A. No.2913 of 2023 arising out of W.P.(C) No.22812/ 2021. The Department is vigorously pursuing the case.

However, since the Hon'ble High Court have not passed any final order the said court cases, the proposed recruitment may be conducted subject to the outcome of W.P.(C) No.22812/ 2021 and other similar cases, if any.



Excess in SEBC Representation

Previously, recruitment to the post of PEO (earlier designated as Village Level Worker) was conducted by respective Collectors of the Districts as the post belongs to the District Cadre.

Further, the post of VLW were filled up by way of selection from among Gram Panchayat Secretaries as per section 4 (1) of the Orissa Village Level Workers (Recruitment and Conditions of Service) Rules, 2008 and from among Gram Rojagar Sevaks as per Section 2 (2) (ii) of Orissa Village Level Workers (Recruitment and Conditions of Service) Amendment Rules, 2013. Subsequently, the Cadre of Village Level Worker (VLW) was redesignated as "Panchayat Executive Officers (PEOs)" vide Resolution No. 19801 dated 10.12.2015 of this Department Since the appointment to the post of VLW as per such provisions was practiced before the introduction of the 50% reservation cap in Odisha, there is excess representation of SEBC employees in some Districts. Hence, the excess representation of SEBC has been adjusted against the Unreserved Vacancies of respective Districts.

In view of the above, this proposal is placed before the Empowered Committee for their kind consideration and views.
